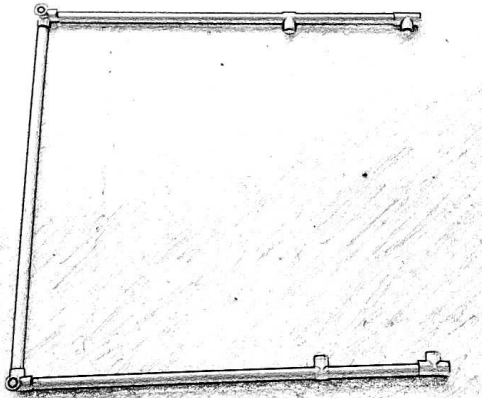


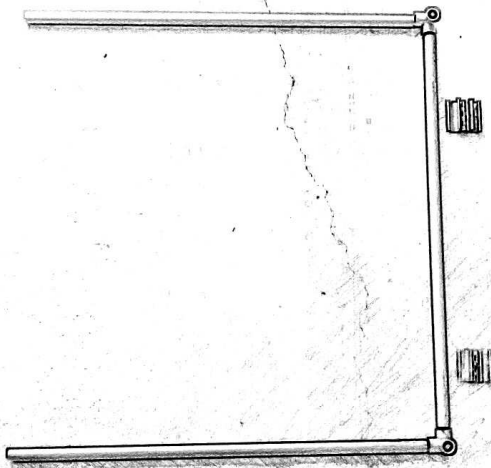
## Portable Chicken Coop instruction guide



**Step 1** - lay down 3 lengths of 1m PVC pipe in a "C" shape.

Connect a 3way connector in each corner gently tapping with a rubber mallet to secure them in place.

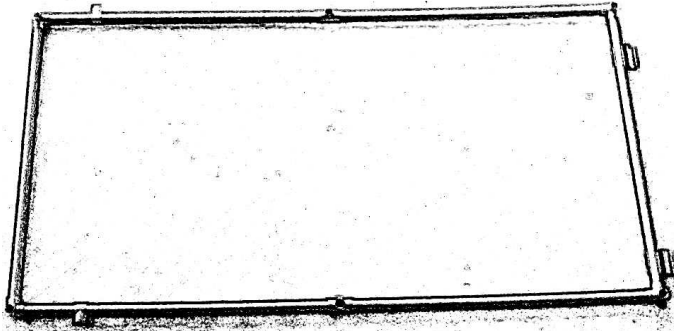
Slide on a slip tee onto each side and add a tee to the ends of the pipe as shown above.



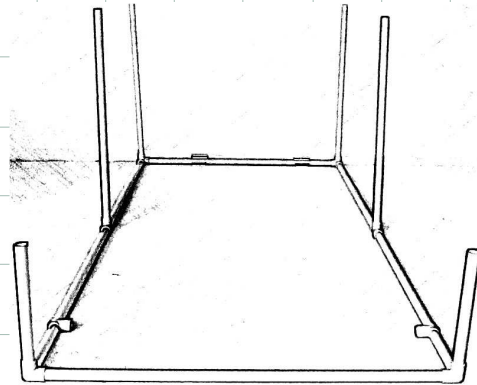
**Step 2** - Lay another 3 lengths of 1m PVC pipe into a "C" shape. Connect a 3way connector at each corner. Between the 2 3ways push the hinges onto the pipe.

### Parts needed :

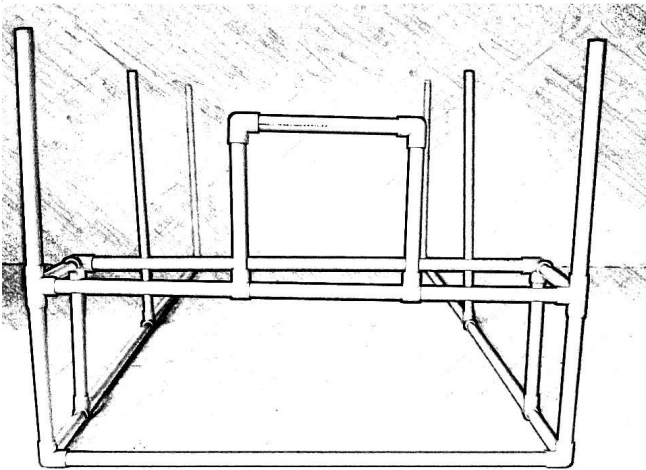
- 14 x 1m PVC pipe
- 2 x 260mm PVC pipe
- 4 x 170mm PVC pipe
- 2 x 210mm PVC pipe
- 4 x 485mm PVC pipe
- 1 x 290mm PVC pipe
- 4 x 790mm PVC pipe
- 2 x 310mm PVC pipe
- 2 x 300mm PVC pipe
- 2 x 450mm PVC pipe
- 2 x 485mm PVC pipe
- 2 x 90mm PVC pipe
- 2 x 940mm PVC pipe
- 2 x 810mm PVC pipe
- 6 x 3ways
- 2 x Tees
- 4 x slip tees
- 2 x Aluminium hinges
- 4 x Ground pegs
- 8 x L-Tees
- 8 x elbows
- 4 x Caps
- 20 x snapclamps
- 10 x cable ties
- 1 x snap cross
- 1 x 20 litre bucket (Not included in kit)
- 1 tarp (not included in kit)
- Chicken netting (included in kit or not - depending on kit purchased )



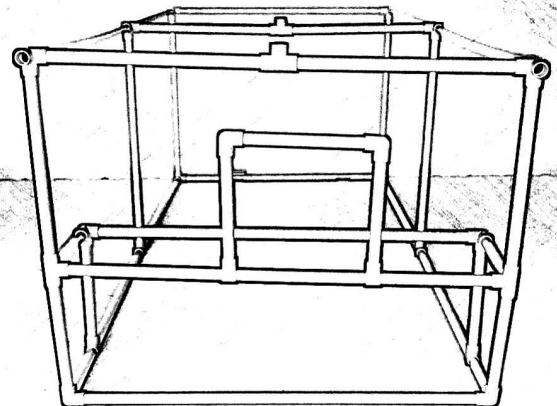
**Step 3** - join the two pieces together from step 1 & 2 at the Tees making sure they are firmly together



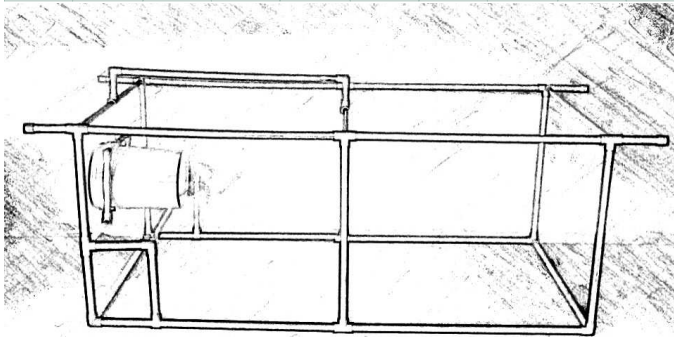
**Step 4** - Insert the 4 x 790mm lengths starting from the hinge end into the 3ways , then 2 in the Tees then the 2 x 300mm in the other 3ways as above.



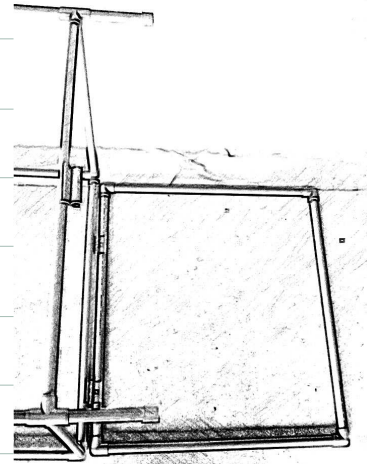
**Step 5** - Insert the 310mm pipe into the slip tees putting a 3way on the end of each and connecting these with a 1m pipe. Attach a L-tee on the end of the 300mm with the 450mm pipe in the ends and the 210mm join to the 3ways to make the shelf. Join the 2 L-tees with a 1m pipe that has 2 slip tees on it. Insert the 2 260mm pipes into the l-tees then put the elbows on the end join these with the 290mm pipe to make a square



- **Step 6** - add 6 L-Tees to the end of the uprights and join these with 1m pipe , the exeption being the 2 horizontal at the front as these are 2 485mm pipe joined together with a Tee



- **Step 7** - insert the 4 170mm pipe into the L-Tees with the caps on the ends. Add the 90mm to the Tees with the elbows at the end of these joined by a 1m pipe. Cable tie the bucket onto the shelf with the lid on the outside of the cage and a semi circle hole in the bottom of the bucket .



**Step 8** - To make the door join the 2 810mm and the 2 940mm with 4 elbows to make a square that clips into the hinges and add the snap cross at the top for a door catch



- **Step 9** - Cover the coop with chicken wire then cover the bucket end of the chicken coop with the tarp securing these at the bottom with Snap Clamps and anchor with some ground pegs



**Step 10** - all finished Welcome your chickens 🐔 into their new home and move it about every now and then so they have fresh grass and enjoy having organic eggs for brekkie 🍳
